Description:

Amendment to Contract #10731 with Pritchett Trucking, Inc. for back-up and emergency hauling of waste from the Leveda Brown Environmental Park and Transfer Station. This amendment extends the term through September 30, 2023.

Recommended Action:

Approve the Second Amendment to the Agreement and authorize the Chair to sign it.

Prior Board Motions:

November 14, 2017, the BoCC approved the original Agreement with Pritchett Trucking, Inc. for backup and emergency hauling services.

September 24, 2019, the BoCC approved the 1st Amendment to the Agreement.

Fiscal Consideration:

Pending approval of the proposed FY22 budget, there will be sufficient funds in account: 400.76.7631.534.42.00 in Solid Waste Fund of \$400,000 for this agreement.

Background:

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To assist the Solid Waste and Resource Recovery staff in its ability to transport the approximately 750-900 tons of solid waste collected each day in Alachua County in a timely manner, sometimes it is necessary to utilize a back-up hauler due to vehicle breakdowns, staff vacancies or instances of higher than normal waste generation.

These services were advertised for bid in 2017, under Bid #17-66. Pritchett Trucking, Inc. was the only responsive bidder. On November 14, 2017, the BOCC approved contract #10731 with Pritchett Trucking, Inc. for back-up and emergency hauling
