East Side Urgent Care Facility

#### **Description:**

Terms of Capital Grant Award to Shands, for one half of the construction cost of an east side urgent care facility. The City of Gainesville will provide the other half of the construction cost and Shands will provide the land and assume all operational losses

#### **Recommended Action:**

Approve entry of a tri-party agreement and subrecipient agreement for a Capital Grant Award of \$2,250,000 to Shands, and authorize the Chair to sign final agreement(s) after review of the County Manager and the County Attorney, and authorize the Manager to approve any necessary budget amendments, for an east side urgent care facility, to be owned and operated by Shands.

### **Prior Board Motions:**

January 25, 2022 - East Side Urgent Care - Term Sheet 22-0016

Recommended Action: Accept the "Eastside Urgent Care Program Description" as adequate terms and direct staff to develop an agreement for a Capital Grant Award of \$2,250,000 to Shands and authorize the Manager to approve any necessary budget amendments, for an East Side Urgent Care facility, owned and operated by Shands or UF Health.

In the event of substantial change in terms between the parties, one or both of the agreements may come back to the Board of County Commissioners for final approval.
