Background:

Purchase order to Cumberland International Trucks of Florida, LLC doing business as Cumberland International Trucks is for a 2023 International CV515 to replace RD731, a 2004 Ford F750 that is at the end of its useful life. This purchase will be downsizing the existing vehicle to meet the operational needs of the Public Works, Road & Bridge Division and will no longer require a commercial driver's license to operate, providing more flexibility within the department.

This purchase is exempt from the County's competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Section 22.3-302(13) of the Alachua County Procurement Code, which permits the County to purchase Supplies or Services under Contract with cooperatives, including cooperatives that the County participates in accordance with Article 10, Section 22.10-201 (Cooperative Purchasing Authorized), providing the vendor extends the same terms and conditions of the Contract to the County; however, since the dollar amount of the purchase exceeds the purchasing authority of the Procurement

Manager, this Purchase Order is being submitted for Board consideration and approval.
